AB 570 (Aguiar-Curry)	✓	Passed Senate Appropriations (8/20) Amended to conform to SB 1130 amendments	Establishes the State Agency Direct Allocation Account in the CASF to fund low-income census blocks to enable telehealth and distance learning

AB 1782 (Chau)		Held on submission (8/20)	Imposes certain consent, privacy requirements on contact tracing applications used by businesses and public health entities
AB 2164 (Rivas)		Passed Senate Health (8/1) Placed on Senate Approps. (8/13) Amended to remain in effect only 100 days after the end of the public health emergency	Removes FTF requirement for FQHC/RHC to establish patients
AB 2280 (Chau)	✓	Not moving forward this session	Extends CMIA requirements to "personal health record information" captured by FDA- approved products
AB 2360 (Maienschein)	✓	Passed Senate Approps. (8/20)	Requires DMHC/DOI plans/insurers to cover consults for MCH psychiatry
SB 1130 (L. Gonzalez)		Passed Assembly Approps. (8/20)	Requires fiber broadband standards for CASF service metrics
